**School Admissions September 2020:** Whether your child is starting school for the first time, or transferring to their next school in September 2020, applications need to be made through the Somerset County Council website at [www.somerset.gov.uk/admissions](http://www.somerset.gov.uk/admissions). For **secondary** school places, the deadline for admissions is **Thursday, 31 October 2019**. For **primary** school places, the deadline is **Wednesday, 15 January 2019**. If you have any issues accessing this online please phone 0300 123 2224.

**WisePay Online Payment System:** Parents/carers can now sign their children up to, and pay for, Busy Bees online. Please choose from 'Busy Bees (3.30-4.30pm)' or 'Busy Bees (3.30-5.30pm)'. The current booking calendar goes up until the end of this term. **Late Bookings:** You can only sign up online for sessions two days in advance so if your booking is last minute you need to contact the School Office in the normal way.

**Kingsmoor Bake Sale:** It is too cold for Frozen Fridays but we think it is the perfect temperature for cake! Cakes will be on sale on **Friday, 4 October** after school to raise funds for our classroom books corners. If you send money in with your child, please make sure it is in an envelope clearly marked with their name.

**PFA Film Night:** The PFA are holding one of their very popular Film Nights on **Friday, 4 October**. Reception & KS1 pupils (Years 1-2) from 3.45pm until 5.30pm and KS2 pupils (Years 3-6) from 5.30pm until 7.00pm. Please collect your child **promptly** at the end of each film. All children to be collected by an adult. Tickets (£4.00) will be on sell in the playground before/after school from Thursday, 26 September (ticket price includes jumbo hot dog, popcorn & squash).

The top gate will open at 2.45pm. The following day, Reception and KS1 will perform their poems. Please do try to attend these exciting events.
