Safeguarding: Keeping Your Connected Home Safe for your Children—Families now regularly use a range of devices that connect to the internet, such as smart speakers, smart meters, fitness trackers and even toys so we need to be aware of the risks associated with this including devices collecting **too much personal information**; children (accidentally or on purpose) being able to search and access **age-inappropriate material**; risk of **'in-app purchases'** which debits their parents' bank account and some devices are more vulnerable to hacking and monitoring, as there are currently no security standards in place for connected devices.
