Primary & Secondary Admissions September 2021: The primary and secondary admission guides for the 2021 admissions process can be found now on <a href="www.somerset.gov.uk/admissions">www.somerset.gov.uk/admissions</a>. Parent/carers are advised to read the guide thoroughly before making an online application. For children due to start school for the first time, the closing date for applications is 15 January 2021 and the national offer day is 16 April 2021. For children due to transfer to a secondary school, the closing date for applications is 31 October 2020 and the national offer day is 1 March 2021. Hot School Meals: We are going to restart our hot meal service provided by Huish Catering (Huish Episcopi Academy) after half term. We are very grateful for their flexibility and the tasty choices in the packed lunches which have been provided since lockdown. The menu will be put on WisePay next week with a deadline for choosing for the whole half term by 9.00am on Tuesday, 20 October 2020. We shall email all parents/carers with more information and to confirm when the menu is 'live' on WisePay next week. Where meal choices have not been chosen for children on Universal Free School meals (R, Year 1 & 2) and those on Free School Meals (any year group) by this date, we will order on behalf of your child. In order to help your child remember what they have chosen, we will be renaming the choices as pink, yellow, green and blue which will be easier than 1A, 1B, 2A or 2B!

**Extended School:** Please remember that you need to pay on WisePay two weeks in advance for your child's continued place at **Early Birds** (Breakfast Club). **Busy Bees** needs to be booked on WisePay two days in advance. If you need to make a booking in an emergency please contact the School Office.
