Maths:

- Whilst out on your daily walk, play I-spy, looking for things beginning with certain letters. Ask your child to sound out the word and challenge them to spell it.
- Listen to your child read daily, and read them a bedtime story. Ask questions such as:
- How do you think the character is feeling? Why?
- What do you think might happen next?
- Why do you think that happened?
- Can you retell the story?
