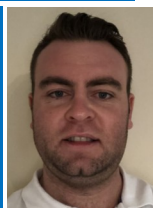

Welcome back: We are looking forward to seeing all our pupils back in school from Monday, 8 March 2021. Drop off and collection times are on page one of this newsletter. All pupils to wear uniform and, on Monday, bring in their PE kit (see Question on the Gate below). Please fill your book bags with your learning packs and completed work for your teacher to take back and mark. Please refer to Mrs Doughty Davis' letter emailed out to all parents/carers on 26 February 2021 for more information (another copy will be attached with this newsletter).

School bags: We would kindly ask you to send your child in with book bags only as this helps with the limited space we have with the classrooms having been adjusted to social distancing. Please check these regularly and empty them out every day. Children should not be bringing in additional items into school.

Masks: A reminder to everyone dropping off and collecting that they should wear a mask. Adults not wearing masks put us all at risk. Please be kind and thoughtful towards our community members.

Water bottles: Please ensure your child comes into school with a water bottle filled with water. We refill bottles throughout the day but cannot supply bottles.

Boosters: Please look out for booster invitations which we ask you to respond to as soon as possible. Boosters are used for multiple reasons such as learning gaps, confidence building and skills lessons. Please contact the school if you have any questions.

School Lunches: Hot school meals are resuming on Monday, 8 March (week 3 menu) and have been ordered for all children entitled to a free meal and those of you who have ordered on WisePay. Please make your menu choices and/or book & pay by 09:00 on Tuesday, 9 March 2021 for meals w/c 15 March 2021 (week 1 menu). Thank you.

Early Birds and Busy Bees: Our extended school provision re-starts on Monday, 8 March 2021. All parents and carers need to book and pay for sessions on WisePay as cash payments are no longer accepted. As there is a limit on the number of children who can attend this provision, please book nice and early as places will be given on a first come, first served basis.
