Staff News: We are delighted to announce the appointment of Miss Katie Plimmer as our new Lunchtime Supervisor and Busy Bees Supervisor. We welcome her to the HEPS community.

Mufti Day for Red Team: On Friday 30th April 2021 Red Team will have a mufti day. The Red Team won the house point competition last term, so it's their turn to receive the award. Please dress in school appropriate clothing for the weather on the day.

School Uniform: If you need a replacement book bag, the navy blue version with our new logo is now available to order along with the navy tie (either clip on or traditional), the latter for Year 5 & 6 pupils only. We do not insist upon the logo on any other item apart from the book bag, so you are able to purchase cheaply from supermarkets etc.

Boosters: All classes are now running booster sessions on a Monday and Tuesday (Sedgemoor has one on both days). These sessions will continue through the Summer Term 2021 but it is possible that the day will change —we will inform you as soon as possible if this happens.

School Lunches: Please make your menu choices and/or book & pay on WisePay by 09:00am on Tuesday, 27 April 2021 for meals w/c 3 May 2021 (week 3 menu).

Early Birds and Busy Bees: All parents and carers need to book and pay for sessions on WisePay as cash payments are no longer accepted. As there is a limit on the number of children who can attend this provision, please book nice and early as places will be given on a first come, first served basis.

Swimming: We are very pleased to report that we have secured swimming sessions for this term. We will be asking for volunteers to accompany us to and from the swimming pool. Kingsmoor - Tuesday Northmoor - Thursdays Isle - Fridays. **This is not starting next week.**

Safeguarding:: We have been notified by several members of the public that children have been coming onto school premises in the evenings and in the holidays. Additionally, children have been entering private property through a fence in the park even whilst under adult supervision. Please speak with your child about these matters as we have done in school i.e. that they are breaking the law and they may be placing themselves in unknown danger.

Even more importantly, we have been notified that a group of primary aged children have been playing on the railway tracks during the holiday. Again, we have spoken to the children about this but we would ask parents and carers to do the same in the most serious of terms. It is extremely important that children are either supervised by an adult at all times or have the understanding and behavior which promotes independence which generally is not in place until children are in Year 5 or 6.

Capture a Comment: *"On Monday we went on the field to build a boat from all kinds of items. This was for our book of The Sea Meets the Sky. We had a great time working together as a group and I know our boat was better because we worked so well as a team."* (Chloe, Kingsmoor)

Question on the Gate: *"Which days are Early Birds breakfast club and Busy Bees closed?"*

"Early Birds breakfast club is not open on the first morning of each half term ie 6 mornings per year. This is because the first day can be a long one for the children and we do not have any food ready for them!"

Busy Bees is closed on the last afternoon of each half term as children are usually exhausted by this point especially as some of the last days have special activities on these afternoons. This also allows staff to undertake a deep clean of the areas and equipment ready for the next half term.

Parents should not be able to book these sessions so apologies that we slipped up earlier this week."
