School Lunches: Please make your menu choices and/or book & pay on WisePay by 09:00am on Tuesday, 29 June 2021 for meals w/c 5 July 2021 (week 2 menu).

WisePay: If you are having problems with WisePay, Mrs Soakell is happy to guide you through any payments if you make an appointment to come into the School Office and bring your phone with you.

Swimming: Huish pool reopened on Thursday 24 June 2021. Swimming lessons will now continue for Northmoor, Isle and Kingsmoor on their allocated days.

If your child has been ill with sickness or diarrhea, they are not permitted to swim until two weeks after the last bout. This is guidance from our pool and the NHS.

We will be refunding swimming payments at the end of term for the missed sessions.

Red uniform: Please hold on to your red uniform until the new term when we will be collecting it all in. Mrs Pengelly is currently finding the best solution to recycle these items of clothing. Please remember we have a second hand store with all items for £1. Any red items of clothing are now free of charge so please take anything for nieces or nephews in other schools where red uniform is worn.

School field: Over the last couple of years the children and Mrs Jones have been improving the field with a small copse, hedges, a willow dome (died last spring but will be replaced this autumn) and a log seat area.

The new trees and hedge need a bit of TLC before the summer break. They need the grass clearing from around them and their stakes and guards tidying. Can you help?

Children are welcome under adult supervision and we will work socially distanced from one another. Bring shears and gloves if you have them but come anyway even if you don't. Please email the School Office or contact Mrs Jones directly if you can help.

Transition: Our current Year 6 children will not be attending the Academy on Wednesday 7 July. We will be expecting full attendance in school on that day with them here. Year 6 children should attend in their sport kit please.

Safeguarding: Domestic abuse can have devastating consequences for children, and can have lifelong impacts on their mental and physical health and behaviour into adulthood. It can also occur between family members, such as between teenagers and parents (known as adolescent to parent violence and abuse (APVA)).
