**Lost property:** We strongly encourage parents and carers to name uniform, especially cardigans and jumpers. We have a mound of unnamed lost property in the basket in the hall foyer so please take a look at it.

**Safeguarding:** We held a fire evacuation practice today which went well (in case your child mentions this to you).

We have been informed by many parents and members of the public that there is a great deal of anti-social behaviour taking place in our community. We would strongly encourage everyone to report all incidents to the police with the names of those who are causing disruption. Unless the police receive reports, and these include names, the perpetrators cannot be supported in the way they need.

Incidents which are in process should be reported by calling 999. Incidents which have already taken place should be reported to 101.
