**Staff news:** We will be very pleased to welcome Miss Grace Cramp as a Student of Childcare Studies to us from Monday for three weeks. She will be working with a different class each week so your child may mention her when talking about their day. Miss Cramp will be complying with the school's COVID safety measures.

**School Lunches:** Please make your menu choices and/or book and pay on WisePay by 09:00am on Tuesday, 17 January 2022 for meals w/c 24 January 2022 (week 1 menu).

**Year 4 residential:** This residential will take place on 4-6 May. A gentle reminder that instalments or the balance can be paid at any time for the Year 4 residential. Full payment must be received by Wednesday 30 March in order for your child to attend. The cost of this residential is currently £200. Schools are not permitted to profit from parental payments therefore any excess charges will be refunded to parents.

**Year 6 residential:** This residential will take place on 16-18 May. A gentle reminder that instalments or the balance can be paid at any time for the Year 6 residential. Full payment must be received by Wednesday 30 March in order for your child to attend. The cost of this residential is currently £250. Schools are not permitted to profit from parental payments therefore any excess charges will be refunded to parents.

**Swimming:** Saltmoor swimming sessions have started, please make your payment on Wisepay.

**World Book Day:** World Book Day will be taking place on Thursday 3 March 2022 and the theme will be Roald Dahl. We will send out more information nearer the time regarding connected activities.

**Willow dome:** Thank you to Mrs Rachel Jones for reinstating our willow dome on the field. The children are very creative with this structure as their home, cave, tent etc during lunchtimes.

**School Council:** The new School Council met this week for the first time. They are going to speak with their class about the options that they suggested for the 10 holiday read treat and undertake their democratic decision. We also discussed fund raising, the library furnishings and water fountains. School Council members will be writing in the newsletter next week with an update.

**Safeguarding:** Recently we have experienced sharp frosts in the morning which have made for challenging conditions. On mornings such as these, we ask children to be dropped at the gate as we have salted the paths to the classrooms but not the main playground. Children are only permitted onto the playground once conditions improve.
