Please note that children have swimming in place of the PE lesson in school so they will not need their PE kit during swimming weeks.

Educational visits: Please contact the school office if you are able to help with any of the trips. Please settle any outstanding payments as soon as possible.

Cockle Moor and Haymoor: Please contact the office as soon as possible if you are able to help with the class trips this week. Without helpers these events cannot go ahead.

Saltmoor: On Monday 26th June, Saltmoor will be heading out into Langport to collect data for our Geography research project on sustainability in Langport. They will leave after lunch and be back by 3.30pm. Children can wear trainers or wellies. We will need two volunteers for this happen. Please contact the office if you are free.

Statutory testing: We are coming to the end of the period when we assess children in statutory tests supplied by the government. KS1 and KS2 tests have now passed. Almost all Y1 children have completed their phonic test. Children in Y4 have completed the multiplication check. Children in YR are being assessed against the Early Learning Goals. All children will receive an end of year written report. Children in the year groups mentioned above will also be informed about their child's results alongside their school report.

End of year reports will be sent home with children in the last week of term.

September: We have booked the team building days for the first week of September off site again this year. The children and staff get to know each other through team building activities. It is such a good day for the staff and children in the first week of term.

These visits can only go ahead if we have enough volunteers. We would appreciate your help if you are able to support these visits.

The new Year 5 and 6 classes will be going on the visit on Wednesday 6 September. The new Year 3 and 4 classes will be going on Thursday 7 September. The new Year 1 and 2 classes will be going on Friday 8 September. Please contact the School office if you can help.

New Reception children: We will be welcoming our new Reception children onto the playground next week for a short 'pop-by' session at 08:40. Parents will meet Mrs Doughty Davis or Miss Chadbourne outside the library so please help anyone who may be new to our community.

Safeguarding: We are so pleased with the growing number of children cycling and scooting to school. We strongly encourage this but children must wear a helmet. Children must not ride their bikes or scooters inside the top gate as it can be frightening to younger children and can cause accidents. We have many vulnerable children and adults who use the school grounds including toddlers and pregnant mums so please insist on your child following these rules.

There have been local incidents of children being contacted through snapchat with wholly inappropriate intentions. Please check your child's device regularly and speak to them about how to keep themselves safe. We deliver frequent e-safety lessons in school so please open the conversation at home too.

Question on the gate: "Will clubs be dependent on my child's attendance from this term?"

"No, all clubs will be open to all children on a first come first served basis at the end of this term ready for September. We will be running a full range of clubs which School Council were discussing today. We will put a note in the newsletter and email all parents ahead of the booking system opening."
