**Staffing news:** We welcomed Mrs Atkin into the team this week. She taught September Perrymoor (current Leazemoor) on Thursday. Mrs Atkin has been a Teacher across multiple Trust schools over the past nineteen years. The children were singing her praises at the end of move-up day this week!

Exercise books: Your child will need to bring a labelled bag for life into school to collect their exercise books on Wednesday next week. The children have worked so hard so there are many books to be sent home. We will keep their current books until the end of term when they too will come home. We would like to keep a high quality set of books from each class so we can refer to them and use them as teaching models. If you are approached by a Teacher about this, please rest assured that the books will be sent home the following year.

**September:** We have booked the team building days for the first week of September off site again this year. The children and staff get to know each other through team building activities. It is such a good day for the staff and children in the first week of term.

The new Year 5 and 6 classes will be going on the visit on Wednesday 6 September. The new Year 3 and 4 classes will be going on Thursday 7 September. FSM children: Children in receipt of FSM will have vouchers issued every two weeks over the Summer holidays.

Book amnesty: We estimate that we 'lose' approximately £1,000 worth of books each year from school. Please take a look at your child's bookcase and around the home so you can return school books to us before the holiday. Don't be embarrassed; we are grateful for every book returned to us!

Swimming interhouse: All KS2 children will take part in the Interhouse Swimming Gala next Friday unless they are withdrawn from the event by a parent or carer emailing the School Office by Monday 09:00. All children will have an event in which they can participate. From children displaying 'water confidence' levels to club swimmers, all participants will be both participating and supporting the event.

Parents will not be able to attend this event on this occasion. We do need volunteer support with the gala so please contact the School Office if you are available to support us on Friday afternoon.

Celebration assembly and bake sale: Due to the swimming gala, there will not be a celebration assembly next week. We will not have a bake sale either as we will return from the pool too late to make the necessary arrangements.

Safeguarding: With warmer weather upon us, children may think that the many rivers which surround us would be welcome relief. We speak with children about the dangers of entering water without full supervision and we ask that you reiterate this message with them too. Children should not be playing in water by the bridge where there are items just below the surface of the water which could cause serious harm. This is just one of the reasons swimming and diving in the area could be dangerous.

Question on the gate: "Will I get fined if we take my child on holiday?"

"Yes, families will be fined if they take holidays during term time. Full details of the attendance policy will be sent home when it has been reviewed over the holiday. This includes full details of the fines which will be issued when attendance is poor.

The Teachers and other staff are very conscientious in their roles. Each time a child misses a day, Teachers must undertake extra work in order to get that child caught up on missed learning. This also takes adult time away from pupils who may need additional support. Children can be affected by having time out of school during term time and often return to the classroom displaying poor behaviour and concentration.

Attendance was particularly poor before and after Glastonbury this year. In order to support families with strong attendance, I have changed the published INSET dates for next year by moving them to either side of the 2024 Festival. I hope this signals how we believe that good attendance is the bedrock of success at school for all pupils."
