School Lunches: Please make your menu choices and/or book and pay on Schoolcomms by 09:00am on Tuesday, 17 October 2023 for meals W/C 30 October 2023 (week 2 menu). You do not need to select a pudding when ordering a packed lunch.

School disco: The School Council have finalised the disco details. We will be a holding school disco on Friday 10 November. It will not have a theme so any clothes or costumes will be fine. The first disco will be from 17:00-17:45 for Years R, 1 and 2. A parent or carer will need to accompany Reception and Year 1 children. The KS2 disco will be from 18:00-19:00.

Tickets will be sold on the evening for £2. We will encourage water bottles to be brought along. There will be a tuck shop selling sweets, crisps and juice. We may also have a tattoo booth although these would need to be removed before returning to school on the Monday. Children must not bring more than £4 into the disco please.

Thinking ahead: Please speak with neighbours, local friends and family about booking in a school visit with us if they have children due to start school next September. For any tour, Mrs Doughty Davis will be happy to accompany individuals or family groups around HEPS so please call the School Office. Even those living close to the school are unaware that HEPS consistently has some of the best results across the county and has such fantastic facilities.

Tissues: Please send your child in with a little pack of tissues in their bag. If they have a cold, please send in a couple of packs which they can take into the classroom. This is an area where we are trying to encourage and improve independence.

Clothes donations: Please bring in any bags of spare clothes to school on Monday 20th November 2023.

London residential: Please could any outstanding balances be paid by the end of October.

PE kit: We have a PE kit which is very simple and inexpensive. Please ensure your child has the correct kit: black shorts/track suit bottoms and a navy t-shirt. The shorts, tracksuit bottoms and t-shirts should be logo free and plain.

Cocklemoor class: We strongly encourage parents and carers to change their child's book on the trolley in the playground. Please only change for a pink banded book at this stage. Please ask a member of staff for help if you are unsure of what to do.

Safeguarding: If children wear earrings to school, these should be small studs only. Hoop earrings or other designs should not be worn. Please wait for the summer holiday to pierce ears so children have the summer holiday to get used to them. If earrings are worn in school, parents should provide tape for PE days for them to be covered. These measures are in place to protect your child from injury.

Question on the gate: "My child says there are lots of visitors coming into her classroom. Who are they and why are they visiting?"

"I'm really pleased to say that we have lots of visitors to our school. Visitors include future families and children; we have had multiple potential Reception 2024 children visiting over the last few weeks and have several more next week. We sometimes have potential applicants for vacancies although we currently don't have any openings. Peers from around the county such as Teachers and Headteachers also visit to see our excellent practice as HEPS has been recommended to them by others working in education. We will also be opening our doors to parents later in the school year to join classes for a learning session.

Please rest assured that children do not stop their learning when visitors enter the classrooms. Visitors are always accompanied by me or another member of senior staff and follow safeguarding procedures. I am always proud to open our doors to show people how hard everyone works and the fantastic curriculum offer we have for our children."
