School Lunches: Please make your menu choices and/or book and pay on Schoolcomms by 09:00am on Tuesday, 31 October 2023 for meals W/C 5 November 2023 (week 3 menu). You do not need to select a pudding when ordering a packed lunch.

School disco: The School Council have finalised the disco details. We will be a holding school disco on Friday 10 November. It will not have a theme so any clothes or costumes will be fine. The first disco will be from 17:00-17:45 for Years R, 1 and 2. A parent or carer will need to accompany Reception and Year 1 children. The KS2 disco will be from 18:00-19:00.

Tickets will be sold on the evening for £2. We will encourage water bottles to be brought along. There will be a tuck shop selling sweets, crisps and juice. We may also have a tattoo booth although these would need to be removed before returning to school on the Monday. Children must not bring more than £4 into the disco please.

Thinking ahead: Please speak with neighbours, local friends and family about booking in a school visit with us if they have children due to start school next September. Mrs Doughty Davis will be happy to accompany individuals or family groups around HEPS so please call the School Office. Even those living close to the school are unaware that HEPS consistently has some of the best results across the county and has such fantastic facilities.

Tissues: Please send your child in with a little pack of tissues in their bag. If they have a cold, please send in a couple of packs which they can take into the classroom. This is an area where we are trying to encourage and improve independence.

Storynory: This club will not take place on the first week after half term, as Miss Taylor will be accompanying the London residential trip.

Clothes donations: Please bring in any bags of spare clothes to school on Monday 20th November 2023.

London residential: Please could any outstanding balances be paid by the end of October.

Lost property: Please ensure all items of clothing are labelled especially the younger children. We have an inordinate amount of school uniform items in the basket in the hall foyer. Please hold onto your order form until you have received your items and are happy with your orders as you may need them to confirm your assigned code for your child's artwork in the event of a query.

Survey: If you are a new parent or carer to the school this term, we will be sending you a survey over the next few weeks to gather your views on what you think we do well and where improvements should be made. Please look out for the email and complete the brief questionnaire. We are keen to hear from as many new families as possible. We will be sending out a survey to all existing parents later in the school year.

Safeguarding: Whilst we understand that trick or treating can be fun for children, please consider the message children are receiving around this activity. We kindly ask that you speak with your child about the possible dangers of knocking on doors of strangers, eating food given by strangers and tricks/threats/intimidation with regards to safeguarding. This can be a frightening time of year for some people at home and this should always be considered by our children.

Halloween falls on a term time Tuesday this year so please be mindful of school-friendly bedtimes and the quantity of sugar children are consuming. It is also the evening before the London Residential where children are strongly advised to have an early night ready for a very busy few days.

Question on the gate: "What's the new pipe at the front of the building?"
