School Lunches: Please make your menu choices and/or book and pay on Schoolcomms by 09:00am on Tuesday, 21 November 2023 for meals W/C 27 November 2023 (week 3 menu). You do not need to select a pudding when ordering a packed lunch.

Thinking ahead: Please speak with neighbours, local friends and family about booking in a school visit with us if they have children due to start school next September. Mrs Doughty Davis will be happy to accompany individuals or family groups around HEPS so please call the School Office. Even those living close to the school are unaware that HEPS consistently has some of the best results across the county and has such fantastic facilities.

Tissues: Please send your child in with a little pack of tissues in their bag. If they have a cold, please send in a couple of packs which they can take into the classroom. This is an area where we are trying to encourage and improve independence.

Clothes donations: Please bring in any bags of spare clothes to school on Monday 20th November 2023. All children will have bought home a bag and leaflet this week with information what they will and will not accept. Please bring the filled bag into school on Monday morning and leave it outside, opposite the Coronation Room door.

Interhouse: Children listened in assembly for the theme of the Interhouse Photography Competition, 2023. School Council decided on the theme 'What make me, me.' They gave examples of a rugby ball, their scout uniform, the sky, and a selfie family photo all which they had taken. The theme is very wide and can encompass almost anything! As this is a photography competition, the image is the most important aspect and that the child has taken the photo themselves. Fundraising: Children in Need received a donation of just under £200 from the mufti day today. The school disco raised a fantastic £330! Thank you to everyone for being so generous.

Lost property: Please ensure all items of clothing are labelled especially for the younger children. We have an inordinate amount of school uniform items in the basket in the hall foyer. Please check in this regularly if you are missing items. Most of the clothing in the basket is unnamed which leads to it being unclaimed.

PE kit: May we suggest knee high socks are worn on Cocklemoor PE days or maybe pack a pair of socks to wear home as children wearing tights struggle to put their tights back on after PE.

Children should be wearing a navy t-shirt and their navy sweatshirt on PE days. PE clothing should be logo and design free.

Wise Up Workshops - free parent / carer workshops : Being a parent carer of a child or young person with additional needs can bring extra situations which are challenging to know how to handle. To help support parent carers navigate these the Somerset Parent Carer Forum and NHS have created a range of free workshops based on subjects such as helping your child with transitions, managing behaviour that challenges, helping your child manage their anxiety and understanding sensory difficulties. Parents evening: Parents evening is taking place on Wednesday 6th December and Thursday 7th December. Booking will take place online. Shortly, we will send out instructions of how to book appointments. Please note the booking system is not through Schoolcomms. The booking system will open on Friday 24th November at 16:00 and close on Friday 1st December at 9:00am.

Kingsmoor class: Year 6 are going to be making fairground rides in the coming weeks. The electric components, glue and cardboard for these will be provided by the school; however if your child would like to make their ride more bespoke, we encourage them to bring in materials with which to decorate their DT projects. Please ensure these are placed in a named plastic bag. Your child will be able to tell you more about the design they have chosen, and the items they wish to use.

Safeguarding: Despite us liaising with the Parish Councils and Somerset Highways, improvements to the crossing and roads around the school are no safer. As it is now much darker and sometimes foggy, please consider investing in some reflective tape, keyrings or sashes to improve the visibility of your child's coat and bag. Pushchairs and prams move from the pavement onto the road before we do. Please consider reflective items on your pram and buggy too.
