World Book Day: This year we are celebrating World Book Day on Thursday 7th March 2024.

As usual, we will be encouraging the children to dress up if they wish. If you would like to get a head start on costumes, our theme this year is 'Picture Book Characters'.

Interhouse cross country: This year the cross country is taking place after school on Wednesday. We are hoping that all children will participate to earn points for their house team. Children can wear their PE kit on Wednesday if they are taking part. There will be squash and biscuits available for everyone who takes part in this fun session. Entry will be £2 on the gate; please bring the exact amount. We encourage water bottles to be brought along. There will be a tuck shop selling sweets, crisps and squash. We will also have a tattoo booth. Children must not bring more than £4 into the disco please.
