School Lunches: Please make your menu choices and/or book and pay on Schoolcomms by 09:00am on Tuesday, 23 April 2024 for meals W/C 29 April 2024 (week 3 menu). Please select 'Packed Lunch Chosen' in the dessert box when ordering a packed lunch option as main.

Lunchtimes: We have started the term with several changes during lunchtimes. A new lunch provider has started positively with children enjoying the new menu which is leading to less food waste—great news! Lunchtime clubs have been a huge hit although some children are still getting into the swing of remembering where to go and at what time; we will continue to support them with this for the first few weeks. Alongside this, we are due to have new members of the lunchtime team and hopefully time on the field. Well done and thank you to everyone for managing all these changes so well

**Uniform:** We have lots of 'new to you' uniform in our store which we would like to find a new home. Please think ahead to the warmer weather and either email the School Office or speak with Mrs Pengelly. Mrs Pengelly keeps our stock and store up-to-date and will reserve items for parents. Each item costs £1—a real bargain! Please help us to recycle perfectly good uniform, some of which still have tags attached.

We are hoping for some brighter weather in the weeks ahead. When the warmer weather arrives, please ensure your child brings a sun hat into school. Sun cream must be applied before children arrive in school in the mornings. Please ensure children with long hair have it tied back particularly in the warmer weather.

**Perrymoor swimming:** Perrymoor will be swimming for five sessions starting on Friday 19th April. If you can help walk the children to and from the Academy please contact the School Office.

Parent Family Support Advisor (PFSA): Our PFSA, Victoria Gould, will be holding a coffee morning in the Coronation Room on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> April at 9am - 9:45am. Please come to the top gate at 9am if you would like to meet Victoria and discuss any issues with her. A PFSA can help you by advising and working with you on issues such as: behaviour (in and out of school), parenting concerns, family issues, emotional/mental wellbeing, confidence building, attendance at school/school anxiety, feeling isolated, support for parents/carers who want to go back to work or education, finance/housing. If you would like any further information please contact Mrs Monk via the school office.

Rounders: If your child attends the Rounders after school club please send them into school in their PE kit on a Tuesday.

Holiday reading treat: The School Council will meet next week to discuss this. Children will receive their treat by the end of next week.

**Website:** We have recently updated our website by reducing some content and introducing new pages. Please take a look at the new information. We only have one more page to update. Do let us know if there is anything else you would find helpful to add to our website.

Attendance: All children had an update of the year-to-date attendance percentage on the school reports from the autumn and spring terms. If your child is struggling with attendance, we have many ways in which this can be improved. This support is based on school and families working together and presenting the same message about school attendance being compulsory other than in a very few cases.

We appreciate the co-operation of families who are providing us with appointment letters—this is almost every family in school - thank you. If parents wish to take children out of school during term time, or permit their child to stay off school, please ensure that the School Office has been informed on every occasion. If this absence is for a reason other than medical needs, the absence is likely to be marked as unauthorised. If children are taken out of school for any other reason, such as for a holiday, a fine is likely to be issued. Fines are usually £60, per week, per child, per parent. These costs increase if they are not paid within 21 days. This money is not collected or received by the school. This is the same system in place for every state school in the country.

We ask parents to consider the impact that absence has on a child for each day they are away from education and the additional workload and pressure this creates for school staff who already work incredibly hard.

Safeguarding: It's that time of year (finally) when all children need to bring a sun hat into school and have sun cream applied before they come into school in the mornings. Each day we are checking the field so children can go on there as soon as the grass is dry enough. The children really enjoy time on the field but there isn't as much shade as we would like so sun hats and suncream are essential.

Question on the gate: "Why don't we get much notice for some of the trips (and some aren't on the termly calendar)?"

"We have a comprehensive programme of planned educational visits which has a balance and progression across the school. This is planned in advance of the school year starting. Many educational visit venues will not permit bookings this far in advance therefore we don't know the exact date until nearer the time. Similarly, we are occasionally sent invitations for events very near to the date they are taking place. Where these events have beneficial content for our children, and align with our curriculum, we endeavor to accommodate these experiences too, even if that means that there is a shorter notice period than we would like. We try to keep these occasions to a minimum but please bear with us when this happens."
